## **Academic Highlights**

### **Parent consultations**

### **Black History Month:**

Each class has been reading a book focusing on Black History that was shared by Ava in Year 2. Each Year group have focused on the concept of curiosity of different cultures and backgrounds. As a school, collective worships have focused on Black History learning of Rosa Parks and the importance of her story. We continue to explore Black History this month and this will continue throughout the year focusing on inclusion and how to ask curious questions of different cultures.

### Music:

Rocksteady and piano lessons have been a key part of our school for the past few weeks, more Rocksteady spaces have become available – please use the QR code on their flyer for further information. These are also in the office.

#### PE:

Last week, Year 5 took part in Archery events while Year 6 took part in Athletics. Reception, Year 1 and 2 have also taking part in outside support from Gosling in tennis sessions.

Children are thriving in sports, and we have ordered a new sports competition kit and Tetra are sponsoring a new Football kit. We are also in the process of
