Aims

The governing board will pay reasonable allowances from the school's delegated budget to cover any training costs that board members incur through carrying out their duties. This policy sets out the terms on which such allowances will be paid.

By adopting this policy, we will ensure that no member of the community is prevented from becoming a governor on the grounds of cost.

Legislation and guidance

The Governance Guide for maintained schools says that boards in maintained schools with a delegated budget can choose whether or not to pay allowances to board members. Where they choose to do so, it must be in accordance with a policy or scheme.

The legislation on governors' allowances is set out in the School Governance (Roles, Procedures and Allowances) (England) Regulations 2013, part 6.

Overview

Members of the governing board may claim allowances to cover training expenditure necessary to enable them to perform their duties. This does not include an attendance allowance, or payment to cover loss of earnings.

Members of the governing board may claim training allowances by completing a claim form (see appendix 1) and submitting it to the Chair of Governors.

Allowances will only be paid on the provision of a receipt or proof of training and will be limited to the amount shown on the receipt or confirmation.

In exceptional circumstances, members of the governing board may claim for extra costs incurred because they have a special need or English as a second language. This will be decided on a case-by-case basis by the Chair of Governors.

Claims will be paid in arrears. Reimbursable costs should be agreed in principle by the governing board before they are incurred.

The chair of governors (or the vice-chair, where appropriate) may investigate claims that appear excessive or inconsistent. All claims will be subject to an independent audit.

Monitoring arrangements

This policy will be reviewed annually by the Resources Committee.
